The Multimedia Project Studio includes two multimedia production facilities for Duke students, faculty and staff.

Both labs feature high-end, integrated hardware and software that encourage imaginative creation and editing of graphics, Web pages, audio and video. Production tools include industry standard software.

- ? Apple's Final Cut Pro Studio for video editing
- ? the Adobe CS3 Master Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, Indesign, Flash, Dreamweaver, AfterEffects, etc.)

The nine top-of-the-line workstations in each lab are equipped with LCD displays and specialized peripherals, such as drawing tablets, scanners, video digitizers and DVD burners.
