DukeWiki

DukeWiki lets groups and teams at Duke easily share information and collaborate online. DukeWiki is located online at wiki.duke.edu

What is a wiki? A wiki is a special website which anyone granted access can edit, directly from the web page itself. Unlike traditional web pages, which only the owner can change, wikis enable more timely, group-driven collaboration.

Why would I want a DukeWiki space? Wiki spaces are great for project teams, workgroups, or other communities that want to share and jointly modify documents like project notes, meeting minutes, lists, and the like.

Who can access my DukeWiki space? Individual space 'owners' control their site and grant access using Duke NetIDs. You can make restrict viewing access just to certain Duke affiliates or make spaces browseable on the web. However, DukeWiki pages can only be edited by those Duke affiliates whom you allow to edit your space, not the general public.
